As we approach the start of the summer holidays, I would like to inform you of some of the activities that are taking place in the final week of term.

Monday 14th July 2025

Tuesday 15th July 2025

8.30am – Year 7 & 8 depart for the Blackpool experience day – those pupils in these year groups that are not attending should attend school as normal in school uniform. All Year 9 & 10 pupils attend school as usual.

8.55am – Year 9 end of year assembly

10.50am – Year 10 end of year assembly

Please note that pupils that are attending the Blackpool trips are not required to wear school uniform but should wear appropriate clothing and footwear. **Pupils are not allowed to wear false nails or eyelashes.**

The weather forecast is for warm weather so please ensure your child is wearing sunscreen and also has plenty of fluids; they should also be prepared for the ever changing British weather forecast. Please note that Blackpool operates a cashless system and food and drinks can be expensive. We recommend that you provide your child with a packed lunch, those pupils that are on free school meals will have a packed lunch provided.

Clean Respect card draw will take place during morning registration.


Normal lessons period 1 – 3
