# Consultation on changes to the schools Admissions Criteria 2021-22

### **Background**

The Admissions Code of Practice 2012 requires an admission authority to consult each time it proposes to make significant changes to its admission arrangements. In accordance with the Admissions Code, a consultation period must run for a minimum of six weeks and take place between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 31<sup>st</sup> January. The process allows parents, other schools, local authorities and other interested stakeholders to raise comments or concerns about the proposed arrangements.

This document is particularly for the attention of parents, other admissions authorities, the local authority and the Diocese of Salford. This consultation will run between 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 and 13<sup>th</sup> December 2019. Information on how you can respond can be found below.

#### **Specific Proposals**

The Governing Body of All Hallows Roman Catholic High School in Salford wish to consult on a change to the wording of Criteria 3 of its Admissions and Over Subscription Criteria.

Following mergers within the Diocese of Salford parish structure we believe it is important to assure parents/carers of children at our traditional feeder/partner primary schools, of our commitment to the established communities we serve. To that end the wording of criteria 3 will be changed to protect and affirm the existing boundary structure.

### Criteria 3, currently reads

Children who are Baptised Roman Catholic and who live in the nominated parishes of St Thomas of Canterbury, St Boniface, St Joseph, Holy Family, Cathedral Church of St John the Evangelist and St Sebastian's

#### Proposed amendment

Children who are Baptised Roman Catholic and who live in the identified catchment area of the following partner primary schools: St Thomas of Canterbury, St Boniface, St Joseph, Holy Family, Cathedral School of St Peter and St John and St Sebastian's.
